This letter is a brief update on what we hope will happen in September. The first day back in school after the summer holiday is Wednesday September 2nd. At the moment there is no certainty that the whole school will be back from the first day but the following plans are based on the assumption that all the classes will return to school at the beginning of the academic year.

Meeting – Wednesday September 9th 2:30 pm

We would like to hold a meeting with you in the hall on Wednesday, September 9th at 2:30 pm to explain school routines and to give you an opportunity to ask any questions.

Teddy Bear's Picnic – Friday September 11th 2:00 pm

On Friday, September 11th at 2:00 pm we would like you to bring your child for a teddy bear's picnic on the school field so that your child can meet their buddy from Year 6. For safety reasons, due to the pandemic, we will be asking you to bring a picnic blanket and snacks/drink for your child.

Transition Sessions (Sept 14th – October 2nd)

The following week (beginning September 14^{th}), we hope to start the transitions in the reception classroom. Your child will attend two sessions in the afternoon from 1:00 - 3:00 pm for the following two weeks. The week beginning September 28^{th} , the children will have a mixture of mornings and afternoons with the aim of having the children in full time from the week after (October 5^{th}).
