English	Reading - information pages on penguins & a further information text on 'The Crown' Planning and producing an information page on penguins - using sub headings to organise ideas. Friday diary: independent recount of the Easter trail.
Maths	Calculating using 4 operations with capacity Reading temperature on a thermometer Using concrete resources to calculate a missing number in an addition sentence. Revisiting odd and even numbers Numbots - bonds and number pattern Telling the time - to 5 minutes with both clock hands. Learning about quarter past, half past and quarter to.
Other Subjects:	PE: multiskills and underarm serve and returning a ball (starting to try to rally) Art: mini portraits & easter bunnies for our French friends. Painting clay pots using different sized brushes for a background and to add detail. Computing: French & Music: Easter song and greeting cards to our buddies outside Paris! Jigsaw through Science: the importance of using soap and careful handwashing. History: Who was Queen Elizabeth? What was life like in Britain at the time of her rule? RE: An Easter trail around the school site exploring the questions: 'What are the stories that Christians tell about Jesus at Easter? How do Christians celebrate Easter? Why does Easter matter to Christians?'
