### English

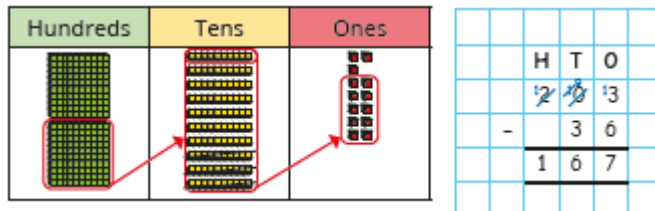
