Lots of Little Reminders:

Please double check everything is named, we have had a couple of mix ups with water bottles already and some clothing is not yet named.

Please send your child with a mud suit and wellies (that can be left in school). We really will be going outside it all weathers and even with their coats on they will end up getting wet without them.

Set of spare clothes to be left on their peg. If possible plenty of extra socks, once we start changing in and out of wellies we always end up with wet socks!

If your child is unwell and not able to come to school please let the school office know before 8.55. If they have had Calpol/medicine but are well enough they can still come into school but please let an adult know at drop off, so we can keep an extra eye on them.

Please let us know if your child is being collected by someone new.

Make sure there are no nuts (Nutella/peanut butter) in lunch boxes, we are a nut free school as there are children with allergies.

Only water in bottles please.
