

This week we have been focussing on getting to know each other and our new school. We went on a tour of the whole school and some of us made maps of the journey. Our buddies came to our class and read us some stories. We have talked about and drawn our families. This week in maths we have been naming and ordering numbers to 10. We have also been representing 10 and other amounts on a ten frame.

Don't worry if any of your children are having wobbles coming in, it is completely normal at this point in the year, when everything is so new. They really are doing so well during the day, you would be so proud if you could see them!

I will be putting up a video onto Seesaw for you, demonstrating the correct pronunciation of phonic sounds. It's important the children learn the correct pronunciation as it makes blending the sounds when reading much easier. Hopefully the video will help you when you are helping them.
