We have started phonics this week. The children have been introduced to the phonemes s,a,t, and p. They have also been listening to words that have been segmented to see if they can blend the sounds to hear the words.

This week in maths we have been singing number songs to 10. We have been practicing 1 to 1 counting, making sure to line up the objects before counting them. We have explored number lines and finding a given numeral. We have been estimating amounts and then using a ten frame to count them objects accurately.
