This week we have been focussing on feelings. We have been talking about recognising our emotions and what we can do when we feel a certain way. We read the colour monster story, where the monster describes each feeling as a different colour. We then drew our own colour monster and said what makes us feel that way. We have been talking about families and how each family is unique, they all come in different shapes and sizes but all that is important is love. The children have also shared the things that are important to them. We have also been talking about the importance of being kind and how we can be kind to each other.

This week in maths we have been sequencing numbers to 10 . We have been recognising the amount of dots on a dice without having to count and we have introduced numicon to match to the number cards from 1-10.
