

This week we have been learning about Harvest Festival. We learnt about why and how some Christians choose to celebrate it. We had our first trip up to the church and sang in our School celebration for the Harvest Festival. This week we have been looking at our faces and creating our own paintings of our faces. We have also been learning about primary colour and mixing them to create secondary colours. We have been learning about different types of homes and describing our homes and building them too.

This week we have recognising numbers to 9 and using number fans to show an amount. We have continued to practice how to subitise (recognise an amount without counting) and we have been learning the different ways to make 5.
