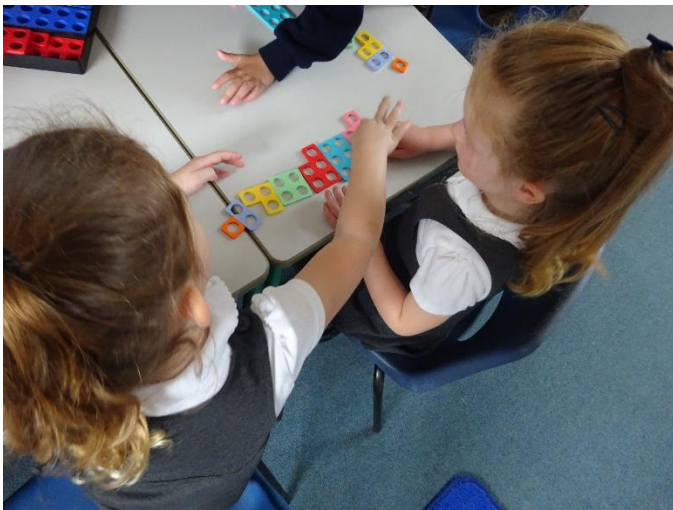


## Wren's News

WB 16th October

This week we have been learning lots about 2D shapes. We have been naming them and learning how to describe them. We have also been searching for them in our environment, creating our own pictures using 2D shapes, cutting and sticking 2D shapes to make a dinosaur, and sorting 2D shapes. We have also been looking at repeating colour patterns and repeating shape patterns and working out what would come next in the pattern.



This week in phonics we have been learning the sounds 'h, b, f, ff, l and ll'. So far this term we have been learning to recognise the following tricky words: I, no, the, put, of, is, to, go, into, pull, as and his.

This week in maths we have been learning about sharing amounts equally, we know when something is equal when there are two of the same amounts. We have also been counting the wholes in the numicon and sequencing it from 1-10 with a partner.
