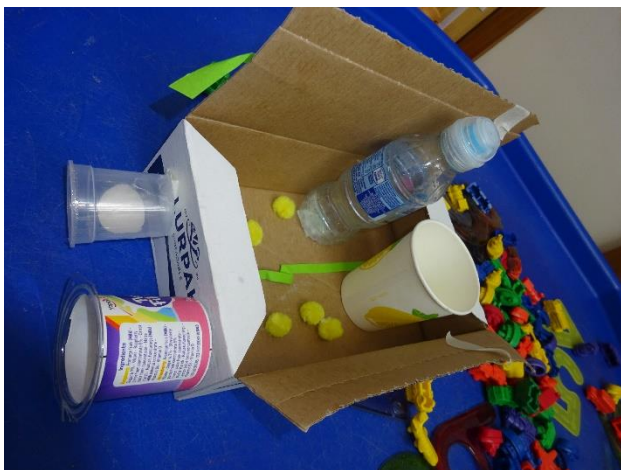
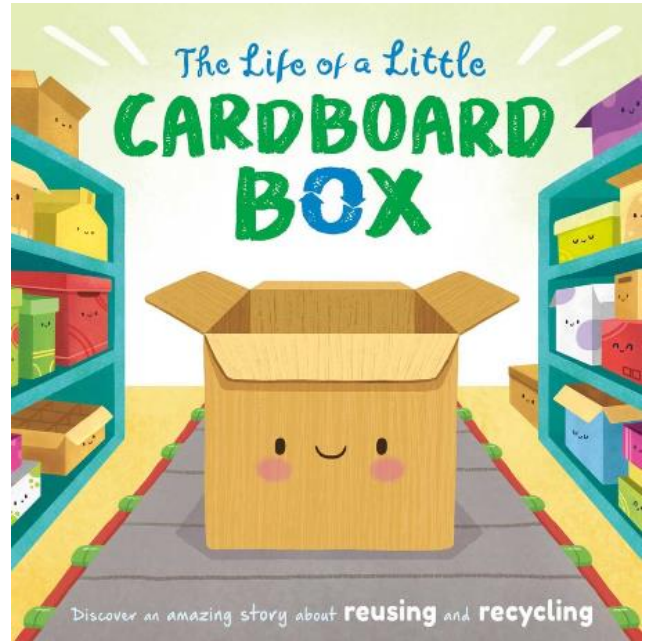


This week we have been learning from the book 'The life of a little Cardboard Box'. We have all designed a model out of junk modelling to show how rubbish can be something new. Then we used different ways of joining our junk modelling and created our ideas. This is the foundation of Design Technology that the children learn throughout school.

We have also learnt about recycling and how different types of rubbish can be reused and recycled into new objects.

The children have been sorting images of different rubbish and learning about the materials that can be recycled.



We have started to write CVC words like cat, box, bin. Most children are able to hear start sounds and are doing really well with blending their words. We have introduced sound buttons and lines to support the children to see digraphs and single sounds in words when they are writing and reading. A digraph is when two sounds go together to make one sound, like 'ck'.
