This week we have learning about Remembrance day. We have learnt about the 2 minute silence and how we think about and remember all the brave soldiers from the past but also the brave soldiers today. We have also been talking about poppies, why people wear them in November and how they help us to remember. We have also spoken about how the money raised from the poppy sales go to people that have been impacted by war. In wrens we have been making our own poppy wreaths, painting poppy fields and creating poppies to wear.



This week in phonics we have been learning the sounds: x, z, zz, y, qu and ch.

We have been practicing recognising the new tricky words: we, me and be.

In Maths this week we have been using our 10 frame to recognise amounts to 10 without counting and also looking at representations of 20. We have been looking at number lines to 20 and working out which numbers are missing by looking at what number comes before and after. We have also explore 100 square and looked for number patterns.
