This week we have been learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali. The Wrens have been listening to and sequencing the story of Rama and Sita, creating their own Diva lamps, fireworks pictures and exploring lots of different ways to create Rangoli patterns.



This week in phonics we have been learning the sounds: sh, th, ng, and nk.

We have been practicing recognising the new tricky word: push and remembering lots of the tricky words we have learnt before.

In Maths this week we have been sharing an amount to 10 between two. If the amount when shared is the same (equal) it's an even number and if the amount is different it's odd. We have also been using Numicon to explore odd and even numbers.
