This week our learning has been focussed around birthday celebrations. We have read stories about birthdays and been talking about how we celebrate our birthday. The children have made birthday cards, written shopping lists and party invitations. They have counted candles and written the numeral to match and created their own playdough cakes. The children all helped to make birthday cakes, which they all enjoyed eating after!





This week in phonics we have been introduced to the new sounds: sh, th, ng and nk. (Two letters making one sound are called diagraphs, ask your child to spot the ones we have introduced in their books) We have also been introduced to the tricky word: push.
