Welcome back everyone, I hope you enjoyed your time with your little people.

This term our learning is all around Real Life Super heroes. We will be learning about different jobs and how they all help us.

This week we have been learning about Vets. We were very lucky to have Bourne Vets visit to teach us about their job and how to take care of animals if we have them at home.



This week in phonics we have learnt the new 'oo' sound (in book/look/nook etc) we have also been reviewing all previous taught sounds. We have been revisiting tricky words we have learnt so far. We are now practicing writing the words we have been learning during our phonics sessions too.

In maths this week we have been comparing height using the vocabulary shorter than, taller than, shortest and tallest. We have been learning about capacity and comparing the number of cubes that can fit inside different size containers. We have been comparing the weight of objects using the vocabulary heavier than, lighter than, heaviest and lightest.
