WB 12th January

This week our learning has been focused around Dentists.

We have been learning about the job of the dentist. How we clean our teeth, why it is important to clean our teeth and food that can help our teeth or food and drink that can create plaque and bacteria and decay if we have too much or don't brush properly. We are spoken about our trips to the dentist and our teeth brushing routines at home. We have also written a letter to the tooth fairy to let them know we brush our teeth!



This week in phonics we have learnt the following new sounds: 'ar' 'ur' 'oo' (spoon) and 'or'.

We have been learning to recognise the tricky words: they, all, and are.

In maths this week we have been learning about 'AB' and 'AAB' repeating patterns. We have used counters, cubes, coloured shapes and bears to create our own patterns. We have looked at number patterns and finding odd and even numbers. We have also been counting amounts to 14 and writing matching numerals.
