WB 19th January

This week our learning has been focused around superheroes.

We have read a different superhero story each day. We started with Traction man, then we read Super Daisy and then Michael Recycle and finished with Elliot the midnight super hero.

We created superhero masks, made lolly stick superheroes. Traced fine motor patterns. Counted superheroes and sequenced them and did a piece of writing called 'Super me'.



This week in phonics we have learnt the following new sounds: 'ow' 'oi' 'ear' and 'air'. Three letters making one sound are called trigraphs.

This week we have been reviewing the tricky words we have been introduced to earlier on.

In maths this week we have been looking at number bonds that make 10, using a part, part, whole model.

We used bean bags in and out of the hoop, teddys in two fields and skittles standing and fallen over to explore different ways of making 10.

We have also been naming and describing 2D Shapes.
