WB 15th January

This week we have been learning all about Drs, nurses and paramedics. We have been talking about hospitals and the Drs Surgery. We have been thinking about how to try and stop germs and infection spreading, especially thinking about why washing our hands properly is so important. The children have been exploring our hospital role play, creating their own ambulances, cutting out items to go in their Drs bag. Painting an X-RAY of their hands and conducting an experiment using water pepper and soap to see how soap can not only get rid of germs but act as a barrier too.





This week in phonics we have been learning the new sounds: ow (growl) oi (coin) ear (year) air (hair).

We have been reviewing the tricky words we have already learnt.

In maths this week we have been using a rekenrek (like an abacus) to help us explore number bonds to 10. We have also been exploring ways of manipulating shapes to create new shapes and looking for smaller shapes inside larger shapes.
