WB 2nd February

This week our learning has been focused around Firefighters. We have been learning about the important role of a firefighter and other emergency services too. We have talked about what we would do in different emergency situations and about the things we learnt when our firefighters visited last week. The children have created fire engines and counted flames using ten frames. This week we have also been assessing the children's phonic sounds and their writing of cvc words.



This week in phonics we have been reviewing all previous taught sounds. We have been learning to recognise and write the following tricky words: when and what.

This week in maths we have been exploring 2D shapes. We have been creating new shapes using 2D shapes. Naming shapes from their description. Singing shape songs and making 2D shapes using pipe cleaners.
