

This term our learning will be centred around growing. This week we have explored seeds and what they need to grow. We have looked at the life cycle of a sunflower and planted our own sunflower seeds. We have also been labelling parts of a plant (root, stem, leaves and flower).

We have planted grass seeds to create our own grass head pots and been comparing different amounts of beans and pulses using the balance scales.



We are still in the review part of our phonics learning, so we haven't been learning any new sounds but just revisiting all of the sounds and tricky words we have seen so far.

In Maths this week we have been learning about odd and even numbers. We have been sharing cubes between two plates to work out if an amount is odd or even. We have been using numicon to help us work out if an amount is odd or even. We used counters with a partner and even worked out if the number of children in class was odd or even.
