

Wren's News

WB 24th March

This week we read the book *The tiny seed*, we have explored seeds and what they need to grow. We have looked at the life cycle of a sunflower and watched a time lapse of a sunflower growing and dying. The children have planted their own sunflower seeds and taken care of them. We have also been labelling parts of a plant (root, stem, leaves and petal). The children have also been exploring a range of fruit and vegetables to find and examine some different types of seeds. They have also painted beautiful sunflowers.



We are still in the review part of our phonics learning, so we haven't been learning any new sounds but just revisiting all of the sounds and tricky words we have seen so far.

The tricky words that we have focused on this week are: children, love, she, do, put, as, there and what.

In maths we have been focussing on number bonds to ten. We have learnt a new song (on seesaw) and been using cubes, ten frames, teddys and ducks to explore different ways of making 10.

We have also been creating repeating patterns with different spring flowers.
