

This week our learning has been focussed around the story Little Red Riding Hood. We have enjoyed the traditional version, The Wolf's story and Little Red and the very hungry lion. The children have made wanted posters for the wolf, created character puppets, made maps for Little Red Riding Hood's journey through the wood. They have learnt to weave and created baskets and made biscuits (for Grandma.)



Phonics: please continue to revisit the sounds at the front of the yellow reading records with your child as often as possible. Focus on a couple at a time and recognising the tricky words too. Little and often with sound recognition really helps them to pick up the next sounds confidently.

This week in maths we have been counting to 100. We have been filling in parts of ten frames and working out how many are missing to support number bonds to 10. We have been practicing accurate 1:1 counting and using Numicon to build 'number cities.'
