In maths we have been looking at teen numbers. The children have been using their fingers to represent Ten and then using Numicon to make a teen number. We practiced counting on from 10, putting 10 in our head and counting to the numeral we need. It was interesting that a few children still do not realise that they always have ten fingers without counting. This is something that you can continue to practice at home.

We have also enjoyed learning about times of the day and clocks, and also recapping our pattern knowledge.
