In maths we have been continuing to subitise, looking at dot patterns for numbers and using our Tens frame.

We are also using our 10 fingers and numicon to represent teen numbers, whilst thinking about other number bonds if we did not start with 10. This is quite tricky and some children need support with this.

Keeping with the space theme children also used 2D shapes to draw a spaceship whilst discussing the properties of the shape.
