

We started the week reading the story Rainbow fish. The message is all about how we can be good at sharing with our friends. The children have then enjoyed a range of activities inspired by the story. They decorated salt dough rainbow fish, printed rainbow scales using celery. They shared even amount of scales between two fish to find half of an amount. Took away one scale and found out how many were left. The children also counted the different rainbow scales and wrote the numeral to match the amount.



Phonics: we have been learning some more new sounds: 'oe' toe, ph 'phone' 'wh' whisk 'ew' crew.

This week in maths we used bead string and number fan to show one more, one less. We played the game I am thinking of a number, its one more than...and one less than... We explored number bonds to 10, each child was given a piece of numicon and he to find a partner so that the numicon made 10.
