The focus in maths this week has been 1 more and 1 less. Every child was able independently to count a quantity of animals and write the number for 1 more and 1 less than the quantity of animals.

We have also been writing number sentences for 1 more and 1 less. We then extended this learning to adding 2 or 3.


The children learnt how to use their number lines to move on a number to add 1 and move back a number to subtract 1. All children were confident to also use their fingers for both subtraction and addition.

On Tuesday the children wanted to make masks and kept Mrs Duhig busy making unicorn masks. They had a lot of fun.

We went to assembly on Thursday this week and watched the Year 5 children mime out the story of David and Goliath. The Wrens sat beautifully and watched and enjoyed this very much.

I know they will love this learning because they all love making their own books.
