

This week our learning has been centred around the story Pattern fish. Whilst reading the book the children enjoyed spotting colour, shape, size and even word patterns in the story. The children have then painted repeating colour fish. Drawing repeating shape patterns, used the duplo to build towers with repeating colour patterns and used the coloured cubes to create repeating colour patterns. The children have also writing a sentence to describe their favourite thing about being in Wrens class this year.



Phonics: we have been learning some more new sounds: 'ey' key, 'au' launch, a-e cake, e-e athlete. The children's phonic sounds have been assessed this week and this will continue into next week.

This week in maths the children have been exploring odd and even numbers and sorting numicon into odd and even. The children have been exploring what the numerals represent in teen numbers ie. The 1 in the number 18 represents 10. The children explore this idea using cubes. We also discussed the similarities and differences for numbers found in a 100 square.
