This week in phonics we have been introduced to new sounds. We now know the sound 'or' can be made using 'au'. 'ee' can be made using 'ey' and 'ai' can be made using 'a-e' and 'ee' can be made using 'e-e'. I have highlighted the new sounds. Where you see a sound like a-e it is called a split diagraph, so the two letters making one sound have been split by another sound. It in the word date.

In Maths this week we have continued learning about odd and even numbers. We have also looked at the part, part whole model for making number bonds to 10. The children have been completing number tracks with missing numbers and working on correct number formation.

We enjoyed having a first responder in Wrens teaching us all about the recovery position and what to do if someone in your home is very unwell. We also got to go in the Ambulance and see lots of the equipment.
