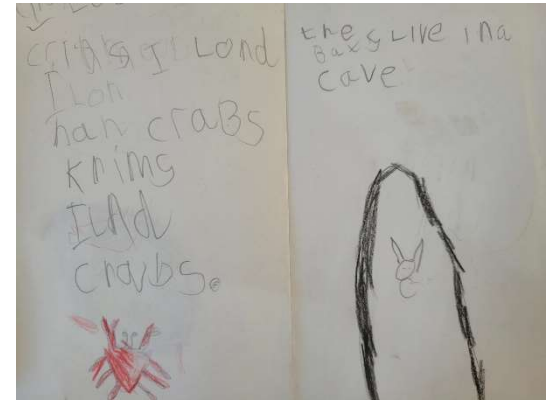
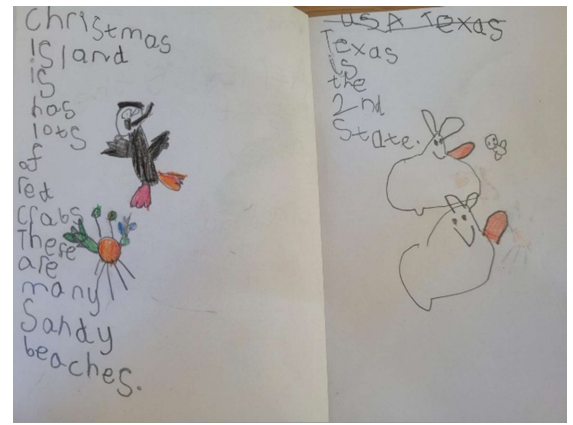

The children are using more maths in their play and are showing confidence in their shape and measure.

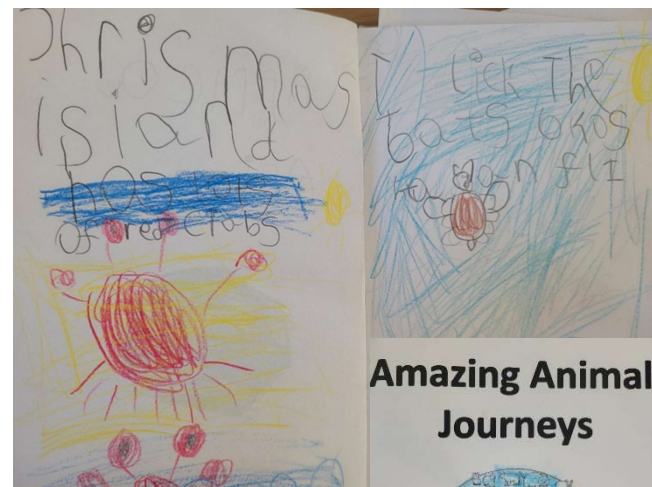
Next week we will go back to the tens and ones and verbally explain our thought process and model using a number track.
