This week we have been learning about:

English	<p>Reading assessment - well done - you all did brilliantly answering tricky questions.</p> <p>Reading to the end of our class book 'Hibernation Hotel' while referring to our predictions. We then wrote information sentences about the native North America mammals.</p> <p>Phonics - ELS phase 5 - alternative graphemes ('s' for <ce> and <se>, 'n' for <gn> and <kn>, 'r' for <wr> and 'm' for <mb>)</p> <p>Writing a diary entry about a special visit from the Spring Lambs (see seesaw for photos)</p>
Maths	<p>Measurement: Building on last week's measurement of length we measured mass (weight).</p> <p>Selecting objects which are heavier/lighter.</p> <p>Measuring with non standardised units (cubes)</p> <p>Using balancing scales</p> <p>Ordering weight</p> <p>Counting in twos.</p>
Other Subjects	<p>Music: practising song with actions for Easter service</p> <p>Geography: after map work of last week we explored sites on our map - what do we like and what would we like to change in our school site.</p> <p>PE: putting accuracy in golf and passing skills with a rugby ball</p> <p>RE: Why do Christians say 'Good Friday' for the day that Christ died?</p> <p>Art: printing and natural paint brushes - making marks with sticks and leaves.</p>
