English	<p>Phonics, reading and sentence construction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Returning to Phase 3 vowel sounds, ai (as in rain) ee (as in teeth) igh (as in night) and oa (as in float). * Reading books and writing words and sentences using the sounds we know. * Exploring the first few pages of our new book - the children have not yet been told the title so I won't give any spoilers! * Thinking about how a character may feel and how they are like us. * Considering what we know about a person from a picture. * Learning how to write on the lines in our new books, keeping letters at a good size.
Maths	<p>Place value within 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Sorting and grouping in different ways, explaining reasons. * Counting objects. * Representing objects as numbers, symbols or numerals. * Matching numerals and words.
Other curriculum areas	<p>Art- Experimenting with different types of line. PSHE - Reinforcing class rules and reprimands. Science - What is the weather like in autumn? We have also started to send home Barnaby Bear to explore the change in day length as we get closer to winter. PE - Multi-skills with the coaches. RE - What is the story of The Lost Son? Geography - How do we map our village? DT - Can I join 2 pieces of paper in different ways? Computing - staying safe online. Music - Learning and practising songs using the mi-so pattern. (Can your child remember Hey, Hey, Look at me?)</p>
