English	<p>Phonics, reading and sentence construction based around Ruby's Worry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Reviewing last week's Phase 3 vowel sounds and introducing oo (as in <u>stood</u>.) * Reading books and writing words and sentences using the sounds we know. * Designing feelings as characters using just eyes and eyebrows in order to develop language for our emotions. * Writing a letter to Ruby to suggest ways to make her worry go away. * Creating a worry cup to add to our emotions pots in order to allow us to speak freely about our worries. * Writing sentences to say what we would do with a worry.
Maths	<p>Place value within 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Counting forwards to 10 from different numbers. * Finding one more. * Counting backwards between 10 and 0 from different start points. <p>The children have explored online maths games to support learning this week.
