


Year 1 - Jays

<p>Date: 14th October 2022</p>	<p>This week we have been learning about ...</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>Phonics, reading, The Three Little Pigs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Re-introducing Phase 3 vowel sounds ure (as in <u>cu</u>re) er (as in win<u>te</u>er) and ow (as in sn<u>ow</u>.) * Reading books and writing words and sentences using the sounds we know. * Rehearsing the alphabet in lower and upper case letters. * Retelling the story of The Three Little Pigs using drama and our 'loud, proud lion' voices. * Learning about Language Through Colour - this week characters were highlighted in pink, actions in yellow, items in orange and describing words in green. * Writing simple sentences for each part of the story - e.g. <div style="text-align: center; background-color: black; color: white; padding: 2px;"> Pig One built a house of straw. </div> * Revising using capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and neat handwriting sitting on the lines.
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Addition and subtraction within 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Learning about parts and wholes and beginning to master use of the part-whole model. I've included an example below - can your child explain which one is correct? <div style="text-align: center; margin: 10px 0;">  </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Understanding how and when the addition symbol (+) is used and why we use an equal to (=) sign. * Writing simple addition calculations. * Realising that these calculations can be written in any order, as long as the parts add together to make the whole.
<p>Other curriculum areas</p>	<p>Art- Exploring different ways to shade. PSHE - How we feel when we face consequences. Science - Why are different materials used for different objects? PE - Multi-skills with the coaches and practising getting feet of the ground in the pool. RE - How do Christians worship God? History - How and why have homes changed over time? Thank you so much for the amazing work you have supported the children to share on Seesaw and in class. The ideas shared about living memory have been truly invaluable. There is still time if anybody else is keen to add something. Music - Learning some more song to sing around the class. Special event! - The children filled their bead jar and enjoyed watching Sing! in class with a biscuit.</p>
