

## Year 1 - Jays

Date: 21 <sup>st</sup> October 2022	This week we have been learning about ...
English	<p><b>Phonics, reading, The Three Little Pigs</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Assessment of learning so far and a review of all phase 3 sounds.</li> <li>* Reading books and writing words and sentences using the sounds we know.</li> <li>* Listening to an alternative fairy tale, The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig.</li> <li>* making story maps to plan our own version of the story.</li> <li>* Writing a short part of our own stories.</li> </ul>
Maths	<p><b>Addition and subtraction within 10</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Exploring number bonds within 10 to recognise the digits that always total 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9.</li> <li>* Working systematically to find these number bonds (in order, spotting that 5+0=5, 4+1=5, 3+2=5, 2+3=5, 1+4=5, 0+5=5.)</li> <li>* Working to remember the important number bonds to 10. This is something we will come back to time and again over the year as it is vital that children commit these to memory as soon as possible to help with all future maths. <b>I've set an activity on Seesaw that you might like to try over half term.</b> There is also an activity practising this on <b>MyMaths</b> - please find login details in book bags. There are a few activities set here for you to try if you want to stay busy!</li> <li>* Adding numbers together.</li> <li>* Adding by finding how many more.</li> </ul>
Other curriculum areas	<p><b>Art</b> - Practising different ways to shade.</p> <p><b>PSHE/Computing</b> - Online safety and discussing how we might feel if things go wrong online.</p> <p><b>Science</b> - Now Press Play - saving a dog from the Wicked Witch of the Waste using our knowledge of materials and their properties. We also spent time with our buddies, exploring their fun science experiments.</p> <p><b>PE</b> - Multi-skills with the coaches and an extended turn on the adventure playground to practise climbing and balancing as the pool was out of action. Swimming has now finished for KS1 until after Easter.</p> <p><b>RE</b> - What can we learn about forgiveness in our own lives?</p> <p><b>History</b> - What have we learned about how and why homes have changed within living memory?</p>
Other information and reminders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* As mentioned above, please do take a look on Seesaw and MyMaths for <b><u>maths activities</u></b> to try over half term.</li> <li>* Please do also <b><u>continue to read</u></b> with your child. We have changed both books today so that everybody has a phonic-linked reader for the whole week. These really are making a huge difference in how quickly the children remember the sounds,</li> <li>* After half term children will need to be in <b><u>PE kit on Wednesdays and Fridays</u></b>. We will be learning dance and football skills.</li> <li>* We finish for half term this Friday (21<sup>st</sup> October) and return to school on Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October.
