<p>English</p>	<p><i>Out and About</i> by Shirley Hughes, Phonics, reading and handwriting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Learning one of the poems (Wind) by heart and performing this as a class. * Recording the poem in groups, considering how to use our voices to good effect (please see the videos on Seesaw!) * Exploring language and images we could use to describe the wind. * Making wind catcher sticks and experiencing different types of wind to inspire our writing. * Revisiting graphemes learnt at the end of Wrens - i-e as in <u>sh<u>i</u>n<u>e</u></u>, o-e as in <u>no<u>t</u>e</u>, u-e as in <u>t<u>u</u>n<u>e</u></u> or <u>fl<u>u</u>t<u>e</u></u> and c as in <u>ci<u>t</u>y</u>. * Reading together as a class and individually. * Using the one-armed robot movement to form r, n, m, h, p and b and their capitals.
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Addition and Subtraction within 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Recalling number bonds to 10. * Adding together. * Adding on more (e.g. 5 + 2 would be solved by putting 5 in your head then counting on 2 more.) * Solving addition stories by finding the important information (e.g. in the following story, children would need to look for the numbers and the word more to understand the addition.) <p style="text-align: center;">There are 4 people in a queue. 6 more people joined them. How many people are in the queue?</p>
<p>Other curriculum areas</p>	<p>Art - Can I find different hues in nature? PSHE - Being friendly. PE - Infant agility and the final swim for this year. Music - Pass it on. RE - What does the story of The Lost Son teach Christians about God? History - What have we learned about changes to homes within living memory? Science - What have we learned about materials and their properties? Computing - Controlling the computer.</p>
