| Maths | <p>Addition and subtraction within 10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Finding 4, then 8 related facts to create fact families: <div style="text-align: center; margin: 10px 0;"> $\begin{array}{cc} 3 + 4 = 7 & 7 = 3 + 4 \\ 4 + 3 = 7 & 7 = 4 + 3 \\ 7 - 4 = 3 & 3 = 7 - 4 \\ 7 - 3 = 4 & 4 = 7 - 3 \end{array}$ </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Using the number line for subtraction. * Mixed addition and subtraction problems. |
