Friday 28 November 2025 This week we have been learning about:	
English	Reading - completed a shared 'reading comprehension' too - practise answering questions on a text. Phonics - review of sounds this week - with some super attempts at spelling too Creative writing - we wrote a letter to Rocket giving advice on how to spot meteors and planets
Maths	Review of subtraction and addition Number bonds to 9 and 10
Other Subjects	Music: learning words and actions to Nativity songs. PE: cosmic yoga and dance RE: Symbolism of the Nativity wreath. We made our own to display then bring home at Christmas time. Art: exploring the artwork of Jackson Pollock and creating marbled decorations. Folding and joining paper to create lovely angels and Using our marbled paper to create giant baubles. We were also inspired by the artwork of Van Gogh's starry night to create woven stars with blue spirals (see seesaw for photos).
