English	<p>Reading, Writing and performing - poetry focus we enjoyed the wonderful poems <i>The Rhythm of Life</i> and <i>Sounds of Water</i> - linking to our Nailbourne running - we will film our own lines in the future.</p> <p>Phonics - ELS phase 5 - alternative graphemes ('s' for &lt;ce&gt; and &lt;se&gt;, 'n' for &lt;gn&gt; and &lt;kn&gt;, 'r' for &lt;wr&gt; and 'm' for &lt;mb&gt;)</p> <p>World Book day workshops</p>
Maths	<p>Working with tens: Skip counting Multiplying by ten - creating Maths Monsters Using beadstrings to show counting in tens We also completed a PUMA maths assessment - this is used across the school to help teaching staff identify any gaps for future planning.</p>
Other Subjects	<p>Music: explore vocal timbre DT: Evaluating our sewing DT - reflecting on how designs help the process, how fabrics are joined in a variety of ways and offering suggestions for future designs. PE: performing a routine on the mat and passing skills with a rugby ball RE: sequencing events in the Bible story of Holy week and Easter? Art: the origins of painting - exploring colour in nature - creating hues with red currants, blackberries and turmeric. Drawing with charcoal from Mrs Gooderham's woodburner. Geography: How do I travel to school - and what do I spot on my journey - landmarks.</p>
