<b>English</b>	<p><b>Phonics, reading, handwriting and exploring a mystery new text</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Revising all of the phase 5 sounds in groups.</li> <li>* Matching lower and upper case letters - <b>please do practise this at home if you have the chance!</b></li> <li>* Thinking about settings and who we might find in a woodland setting.</li> <li>* Exploring what we think we already know about book characters.</li> <li>* Looking at language in books for clues about what will happen.</li> <li>* Retelling Little Red Riding Hood through drama and story mapping, thinking about the different versions we have heard and why they exist.</li> </ul>
<b>Maths</b>	<p><b>Place Value within 50, Length and height, International Day of Maths</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Revising learning about numbers to 50.</li> <li>* Carrying out a scavenger hunt for shapes and numbers around the classroom.</li> <li>* Exploring the language we use for measurement.</li> <li>* Measuring items using non-standard units such as cubes or paper clips.</li> </ul>
