This week we have been learning about:

English	Started activities on our new class book - Stanley's Stick - we have written about what our own sticks would be used for, chose adjectives to describe the different settings in this book and then considered character feelings when writing about how Stanley felt when he threw his stick into the sea. Phonics - review week and assessments - we are sending home some phonics cards to practise over the holidays. Writing a diary entry about Mrs Shilling visiting our class to read. We used 'because' in a sentence.
Maths	Measurement: this week we have looked at capacity and volume: Full and empty Comparing volume Discussing capacity Measuring capacity in jugs and scales. We have looked at doubling too.
Other Subjects	Music: practising song with actions for Easter service Geography: recycling matters - sorting rubbish that we might find on our school site into recycling bins PE: crazy golf - skills and thinking ideas for a course we will make next week. Passing and intercepting the ball in rugby. RE: What impact does the Easter story have on many Christians? Art: printing with bubbles and fingers - creating a reflective card for RevT (his last service with us is next week). Computing: how is data grouped?
Other information	Reminders: PE days continue to be Tuesday and Wednesday. Please wear PE kits (with sports shoes that provide support to the foot) and if possible remove earrings too. Next Thursday is our Easter Service at 2pm in St John's church, Barham (all families welcome).
