Other curriculum areas	<p>History - Why is nursing important? Who were significant nurses in history?</p> <p>Art - Finishing pop-art lettering.</p> <p>PE - Just lots of chances to use the field and exercise equipment in the sunshine as we missed our PE days this week.</p> <p>Science - What parts do all bodies have? What body parts are specific only to humans?</p> <p>DT - making moving pictures using wheel mechanisms.</p>
