| English | Reading - lovely book chatter on some picture books and another wonderful library session with Mrs Shilling. We designed a 'lost and found' leaflet for Beegu - using adjectives in our sentences. Phonics: revising unit. We continue to practice our handwriting too - keeping it on the line and writing letter of the alphabet as capitals. |
| Maths | Practice making a number with the part-whole model. Recognising the + as a symbol to add. Understanding fact families (that + can be in any order in a number sentence). |
| Science | Continued with materials - investigating floating and sinking objects. |
| Other Subjects: | Music: play a steady pulse using untuned percussion instruments. PE: Practising strong freestyle kicking and putting our faces in the water in swimming. We worked on footwork and catching skills (considering timing when throwing a beanbag up high) RE: How and why do Christians pray? Art: colour-mixing primary colours to create secondary colours (look out for our lovely artwork when you visit the school next week. PSHE: relationships - working with others. Computing: using the ipads to create an image. |
