


OWLS CLASS (Year 2) - Weekly overview

Friday 8th September 2023	This week we have been learning about:
English	Reading clues on our dotty trail (working together) - All children were all given a reading book for home reading - please can you sign reading records. Finding descriptive words for the weather and listening to a poet share his poem on weather-emotions. Drafting and expanding on detail in a piece of writing (our first on display!). Friday diary - our first week in Owls
Maths	Place value: tens and ones - recording in a variety of ways  Friday maths: recognising 2d and 3d shape
Science	Introduction to Animals & Habitats: How do scientists classify objects? Living? Never Alive? Died?
Other Subjects:	PE: Sprinting and throwing & catching Jigsaw: Discussing 'growth mindset' & watching 'The Dot' - creating our own 'dotty bunting' to remind us we are all individuals. Our rights and responsibilities in school - what makes our classroom a great place to learn - creating our class rules.
