Friday 13th September	This week we have been learning about:
English	<p>Reading carousels - all children will have participated in small group comprehension exercises and reading for pleasure.</p> <p>We were very lucky to be the first class to experience the library tour with Mrs Shilling! She showed us how to find books and we have all brought home a book to enjoy with some of our family (not linked to reading ability - more for sharing). Taken out using the library lending software.</p> <p>Started to enjoy and work on our class text 'Lila and the Secret of the Rain' sequencing events on a storymap (with time adverbials), Discussing characters feelings and using the word 'because' when writing about why we liked a particular part of the story.</p> <p>Friday diary - using capitals in days of the week.</p>
Maths	<p>Place value: recognising value of a digit, partitioning to tens and ones and writing numbers to 100 in words.</p> <p>Friday maths: counting sides of 2d shapes</p>
Science	Which living things choose the pond as it's habitat. Recording in drawings and words.
Other Subjects:	<p>PE: Hockey and swimming</p> <p>Art: drawing light and dark tones in spheres</p> <p>Handwriting: horizontal lines</p> <p>Computing: Exploring maps digitally & thinking about how IT is used outside our school building.</p> <p>Music: Body percussion to a traditional Kenyan song.</p> <p>Geography: knowing the difference between physical and human features on a map. What is a landmark?</p> <p>RE: the Qu'ran as a special book that Muslims look after carefully</p>
