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| This week we have been learning about: | |
| English | Started work on non- chronological reports. Mind mapping ideas for a shared writing task on big cats. Reading – continued comprehension groups and 'drew an image from words' Friday diary – editing to ensure punctuation is correct in our diary writing. |
| Maths | Begun addition and subtraction: Related number facts (using lots of concrete resources to help with calculating). Drawing links between number bonds to 10 and 100. Finding lines of symmetry, symmetrical shape and making a symmetrical pattern. |
| Science | Recording habitats and signs of habitats. Investigating – what is the perfect home for a woodlice? |
| Other Subjects: | PE: balances and swimming. Art: collage (for display board based on the artist Charles McGee), blending colour with paint to make a sunset background. Geography: Why visit Kent (a postcard to France) which we will use to contrast why visit Kenya. PSHE: 'mind your manners' - we reflected on how to behave in the dinner hall, at home and with different people. 'What makes a good friend' - how to deal with choices in our friendship groups. Computing: being safe online - a Now Press Play drama which took us inside a computer game and made us reflect on not sharing personal data Music: Using non tuned percussion instruments to produce an African beats rhythm. RE: Stories about the Prophet Muhammad* that inspire Muslims to look after animals, the planet and everyone. Focus on 'the story of the Prophet and the cat'.
