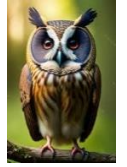




# OWLS CLASS (Year 2) - Weekly overview

This week we have been learning about:

English	<p>Wrote sections, then edited and published our non-chronological reports on Cheetahs with a focus on how to use questions (and punctuating with a question mark) and thinking about grouping ideas into sections.</p> <p>Reading - finished the Owl who was afraid of the dark and comprehension/retrieval task.</p> <p>Friday diary - practising full stops and capital letters for different types of words.</p>
Maths	<p>Using lots of concrete resources to help with addition and subtraction when crossing tens boundaries.
