Guided Reading: We have again been looking at information texts and learnt how to answer multiple choice questions.

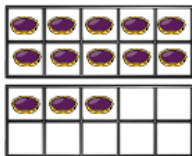
Spelling focus: Our spelling words for this week have all contained the grapheme 'ear'.

Maths

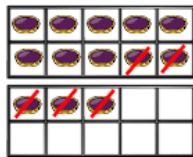
Place Value:

We have continued to learn about place value and the value of 10s and 1s in 2 digit numbers. We have been using base 10 (chips and peas) to represent 10s and 1s. We have been adding and subtracting 2 digit and 1 digit numbers using number lines to help us, either to find the nearest 10 first or to jump forwards/back in 1s.

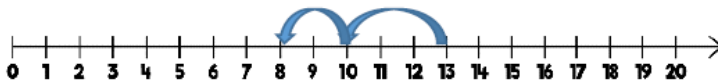
First there were 13
