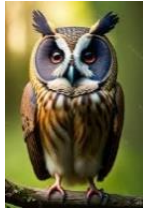




OWLS CLASS (Year 2) - Weekly overview

Friday 6 th December 2024: This week we have been learning about:	
English	Drama: incredible performances at Nativity. Reading an invitation Responding to an invitation. Drafting and editing a letter. Word work on common exception words - spellings on spellingshed! Friday diary - writing about Barham Nativity using Language through Colour.
