English	<p>We have continued to use the book 'The Princess and the White Bear King' by Tanya Robyn Batt and written another diary entry as the princess and a character description before finally hearing how the story ended! We finished the week by devising a story map and writing the first half of the story.</p> <p>Snowy Owls have been working very hard in their English sessions. We have been retelling the story of Little Red Riding Hood and making up our own version of Eric Carle's 'Brown bear, brown bear, what do you see?' In phonics, we have reviewed the following sounds: ie (pie), oy (toy) and ea (sea). Please listen to your child read at home as often as you can. Thank you. Maths	<p>Money:</p> <p>This week we have completed our work on money. We have learnt that 100p = £1, worked out how to give change and progressed onto some very tricky word problems.</p> <p>A scarf is £12 and a bag is £25 Sam buys one of each. She pays with a £50 note. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RE - This week we listened to the story of the ten lepers and discussed if it is important to say thank you? • Topic - we considered the 2 questions: What was it like for Walter Tull when he played football at a match in Bristol? And how did Walter help our country during WWI? • Music - We listened again to Orawa (pronounced Arva) and composed a coda (Coda means tail so it is an ending) to add on to our chants from last week. • Computing - we logged onto turtle logo and started to programme our turtles to draw shapes on the screen. • Science - We considered the 2 questions: How do animals change as they grow? And what do animals need to survive? • PE- Dance - we chose one of the days of Creation to develop some solo work. Infant agility - we developed the skills needed for bouncing and running.
