### Term 4 Week 1

Friday 23 February 2024 This week we have been learning about:	
English	Reading comprehension - space (copy sent home so you can see the types of questions) We began to read our new text - 'The Crows Tale' (A native American tale) and had a lot of fun using drama to empathise with characters and create thought bubbles. Starting sentences with a verb and then with a preposition. Carefully selecting language to describe events and birds. Friday diary with a focus on sentence openers (When ... If ...)
Maths	Recognising and highlighting odd and even numbers Continued with multiplying and dividing by 10 Number bond and times table practise with Numbots. Telling the time with o'clock - using the hour hand and introducing the clock as a circular number line.
Science	Completing a survey - recording findings as a tally and as a pictogram Recalling our pizza recipes and recording ingredients in a table - to show that many of the food groups were used
Other Subjects:	PE: multiskills and an introduction to tennis Jigsaw: 'Teamwork makes the Dreamwork' & this term's focus has a strong link to our science topic - healthy me! Geography: reading a postcard that was received from Sri Lanka! We then watched a family tourist clip and designed our own Persuasive Brochure of what can be visited in the town of Kandy. Art: Colour mixing to create beautiful feathers for our own Rainbow Crow Art: 'Sculpture' - introducing techniques such as cutting, rolling and coiling. Music: How music makes me feel - listening to Jean Sibelius's Finlandia and responding with brush strokes. RE: What is Humanism? Handwriting: we are focusing on joining three letters together ('oor and our')
