English	<p><b>Pattan's Pumpkin</b></p> <p>We started our new book this week, we explored the story through illustrations, predictions and descriptive language. We responded to the text by inferring characters' thoughts and feelings, visualising scenes and creating drawings with written captions.</p>
Maths	<p><b>Mass, capacity and temperature</b></p> <p>We practised comparing, adding and subtracting mass by reading scales carefully and choosing the correct operation to solve problems. We explored volume and capacity, comparing containers and measuring liquids in millilitres and litres using practical equipment.</p> <p>We did a fun practical lesson outside today which the children all loved.
